Qualification Description

This is a qualification for those engaged in operational roles within a stevedoring environment. It involves a range of tasks involving known routines and procedures and taking some responsibility for the quality of work outcomes.

Successful achievement of the licensing units within the qualification must align with applicable licensing and regulatory requirements.

- stevedore.
