Modification History

Release 3. This is the third release of this qualification in the TLI Transport and Logistics Training Package. The following changes have been made:

- TLILIC2002 Licence to operate an order picking forklift truck has been replaced with TLILIC0004 Licence to operate an order picking forklift truck.

Release 1. This is the first release of this qualification in the TLI Transport and Logistics Training Package.

Qualification Description

This is a general qualification for the Warehousing and Storage Industry.

It involves a defined range of skilled operations, usually within a range of broader related activities involving known routines, methods and procedures, with some discretion and judgement in selecting equipment, services or contingency measures and within known time constraints.

No licensing, legislative or certification requirements apply to this qualification at the time of publication.

Entry Requirements

There are no entry requirements for this qualification.

Packaging Rules

A total of **19 units of competency** comprising:

3 core units listed below **plus**

16 general elective units from the general elective units listed below. Up to **3 of the general elective units** may be selected from any relevant nationally endorsed Training Package or accredited course. The general elective units must contribute to the vocational outcomes of the qualification.
