Release 1. This is the first release of this qualification in the TLI Transport and Logistics Training Package.

Qualification Description

This is a qualification for those engaged in the Transport and Logistics Industry in a scheduling role.

It involves a broad range of applications including requirements for:

- allocating staff and resources
- planning routes
- optimising delivery service
- contingency planning
- effective stakeholder engagement
- chain of responsibility obligations.

It ensures regulatory compliance is met for all types of freight including but not limited to:

- break bulk
- bulk cargo/freight
- bulk liquid
- container/s
- couriers within the logistics industry
- dangerous goods
- furniture
- general
- livestock
- over dimension
- passengers
- refrigerated
- vehicle/mobile plant transport.

Additionally, the qualification provides skills in leading teams, just in time delivery, load security/integrity, optimising the use of telematic data in cost effective journey planning and delivery.

Job roles

Job roles and titles vary across different sectors. Possible job titles relevant to this qualification include:

- transport scheduler
- transport allocator
- rail operations scheduler
- maritime scheduler
- aviation scheduler.

No licensing, legislative or certification requirements apply to this qualification at the time of publication.

Entry Requirements

There are no entry requirements for this qualification.

Packaging Rules

A total of 14 units of competency comprising:

4 core units listed below plus

1 of the GROUP A specialist elective units (Fatigue risk management) plus

1 of the GROUP B specialist elective units (Regulatory)

8 general elective units from the general elective units or Group A or Group B specialist units.

Up to **3 of the general elective units** may be selected from any relevant nationally endorsed Training Package or accredited course. The general elective units must contribute to the vocational outcomes of the qualification.

Where imported units are selected, care must be taken to ensure that all prerequisite units specified are complied with.
