- transport supervisor

Successful achievement of the licensing unit in the qualification must align with licensing and regulatory requirements applicable to driving and state or territory regulatory requirements.

Entry Requirements

There are no entry requirements for this qualification.

Packaging Rules

A total of **12 units** of competency comprising:

- 5 core units, plus
- All units in one of the specialist elective groups, plus
- 5 general elective units if selecting specialist elective Group, A, B, D, or
- 6 general elective units if selecting specialist elective Group C.

Up to 3 of the general elective units may be selected, from any relevant nationally endorsed Training Package or accredited course. The general elective units must contribute to the vocational outcomes of the qualification.
