Modification History

Release 1. This is the first release of this unit of competency in the TLI Transport and Logistics Training Package.

Application

This unit involves the skills and knowledge required to connect and disconnect reefer units in accordance with workplace requirements as part of work activities in the stevedoring, transport, distribution and allied industries.

It includes plugging and unplugging reefer units to/from power sources, attaching and detaching reefer units, and identifying and reporting any problems with reefer unit operation.

Work is performed under some supervision generally within a team environment.

No licensing, legislative or certification requirements apply to this unit at the time of publication.

- 2.1 Units are attached/detached safely in accordance with regulatory and code of practice requirements, and workplace procedures
 - 2.2 Problems with the operations of units are identified and reported to appropriate personnel
