| | 2.2 | Plant and equipment requiring service or repair are identified and reported to relevant person/s in accordance with workplace procedures and manufacturers' specifications |
| 3 | Maintain records on plant and equipment | |
| | 3.1 | Plant and equipment maintenance information is recorded in accordance with regulatory requirements and workplace procedures |
| | 3.2 | Records are clear and accurate and kept up to date in accordance with workplace procedures |
| | 3.3 | Records are secured and accessed in accordance with workplace procedures |
| | 3.4 | Registration and insurance is current and appropriate for the plant and equipment in accordance with regulatory requirements and workplace procedures |
