Application

This unit involves the skills and knowledge required to use communication systems in a taxi.

It includes identifying features of taxi communication systems and operating it effectively, using appropriate communication protocols. It also includes identifying and reporting faulty communication equipment and taking appropriate action. Communication systems are used in accordance with manufacturer instructions, road laws, safe driving practices and workplace policies and procedures.

Safety checks and equipment tests are performed with limited or no supervision, and with full accountability and responsibility for self and others in achieving the prescribed outcomes.

No licensing, legislative or certification requirements apply to this unit at the time of publication.
