Modification History

Release 1. This is the first release of this unit of competency in the TLI Transport and Logistics Training Package.

Application

This unit involves the skills and knowledge required to prepare for and transport a load while operating a car carrier vehicle.

It includes preparing for a trip, loading car carrier vehicle, transporting load and unloading car carrier vehicle.

Work must be carried out in accordance with relevant state/territory roads and traffic authority licence requirements and regulations for heavy vehicles.

Work is performed with limited or minimum supervision, and with duty of care responsibility for self and others in achieving the prescribed outcomes.

No licensing, legislative or certification requirements apply to this unit at the time of publication.

1 Prepare for trip

1.1 Job hazards are identified and required action is taken to minimise, control or eliminate identified hazards

- 1.2 Inventory of equipment is completed in accordance with organisational requirements
- 1.3 Driver clothing is selected in accordance with organisational and customer requirements
- 1.4 Vehicles assessed as unsuitable for car carrier are excluded from loading in accordance with organisational requirements
- 1.5 Inspection documentation for vehicles to be loaded is completed in accordance with organisational and customer requirements
- 1.6 Delivery instructions, including verbal instructions for pick-up points and destinations, are checked to ensure they are consistent with manifest, and inconsistencies are remedied in accordance with organisational requirements
- 1.7 Suitable route is selected to ensure most efficient, safe and secure route for load

2 Load car carrier vehicle

- 2.1 Car carrier vehicle is loaded without damage to vehicles, in the correct order and in accordance with organisational requirements
- 2.2 Vehicles are loaded onto car carrier vehicle in accordance with regulatory requirements, and organisational safety and operating procedures, and adjustments are made as required when loading commercial vehicles
- 2.3 Vehicles are parked in gear and brakes are applied
- 2.4 Load is secured with correct tie down methods for transporting vehicles in accordance with organisational requirements
- 2.5 Checks are made to ensure loaded car carrier complies with legal requirements for height, weight, width and axle loading
- 2.6 Ancillary equipment attached to car carrier is operated in accordance with operating instructions

3 Transport load

- 3.1 Driving techniques are used, when operating car carrier, to minimise risk of damage to loaded vehicles in accordance with eco-driving considerations
- 3.2 Load is conveyed to meet customer requirements for delivery times and road traffic laws are complied with

- 3.3 Loaded vehicle car keys are secured in accordance with organisational requirements
- 4 Unload car carrier vehicle
- 4.1 Identity of persons taking delivery of vehicles is confirmed in accordance with delivery instructions
- 4.2 Vehicle unloading procedures are followed in accordance with organisational and customer requirements for safety, and in a manner that minimises inconvenience to other road users
- 4.3 Unloaded vehicles are inspected and documentation of their condition is completed
- 4.4 Variances from initial vehicle inspection are reported, in accordance with organisational and customer requirements
