1.4 Alternative communication strategies are used to communicate messages in response to communication failures and problems

2.1 Records on oversized and overmassed vehicle movements are maintained in accordance with workplace procedures and documentation requirements

2.2 Damage and other incidents are reported clearly and legibly to appropriate authorities in accordance with relevant rules, regulations and workplace procedures
