1 Perform pre-start checks to minimise in-vehicle technology distractions

PERFORMANCE CRITERIA

Performance criteria describe the performance needed to demonstrate achievement of the element.

- 1.1** Drivers' cabin is set-up and organised to minimise technology distractions in accordance with workplace policies and procedures
- 1.2** Drivers' cabin technology is started and checked in accordance with manufacturer instructions, workplace

policies and procedures

- 1.3 Faulty equipment or damage is detected and reported in accordance with workplace policies and procedures
 - 1.4 Lighting is adjusted and obstructions to accessing technology are removed in accordance with workplace policies and procedures (where relevant)
- 2 Implement strategies to minimise in-vehicle technology distractions**
- 2.1 Relevant road rules, workplace policies and procedures for managing technology distractions are complied with
 - 2.2 Low risk driving strategies to minimise technology distractions are applied
 - 2.3 Technology alarm, alert or warning is responded to in accordance with relevant road rules, workplace policies and procedures
 - 2.4 Potential causes of distraction are identified and actions taken to minimise their effects in accordance with workplace policies and procedures
