ELEMENTS

Elements describe the essential outcomes.

1 Check firefighting equipment

2 Use firefighting equipment

PERFORMANCE CRITERIA

Performance criteria describe the performance needed to demonstrate achievement of the element.

1.1 Firefighting equipment is checked for serviceability in accordance with manufacturer instructions and regulatory requirements

1.2 Non-functioning equipment or equipment past its service date is identified and reported to designated personnel for replacement or service

2.1 Equipment and personal safety equipment used for fighting fires are correctly selected for type of fire in accordance with manufacturer instructions

2.2 Fire is controlled using firefighting equipment in accordance with manufacturer instructions and workplace emergency response procedures

2.3 Equipment is stored safely in accordance with manufacturer instructions and workplace procedures

Foundation Skills

Foundation skills essential to performance are explicit in the performance criteria of this unit of competency.

Range of Conditions

Range is restricted to essential operating conditions and any other variables essential to the work environment.
