	<b>2.2</b> Activities are carried out in accordance with industry regulations, codes of practice or guidelines, work health safety (WHS)/occupational health and safety (OHS), environmental and workplace policies and procedures
	<b>2.3</b> Hazards are identified, risks are assessed, and control measures are implemented
	<b>2.4</b> Accurate and legible records for operation within the workplace are completed in accordance with transport regulations and workplace policies, procedures and legislative requirements
	<b>2.5</b> Compliance with transport regulations and codes of practice are assessed to ensure legal requirements are maintained as a minimum and exceeded where possible
<b>3 Review operations in accordance with transport regulations</b>	<b>3.1</b> Improvements to transport workplace policies and procedures are identified
	<b>3.2</b> Improvements to effectiveness of transport regulations, workplace policies, procedures and programs are suggested
	<b>3.3</b> Compliance with transport regulations is assessed and modifications are made, as required
