Performance Evidence

Evidence required to demonstrate competence in this unit must be relevant to and satisfy all of the requirements of the elements and performance criteria on at least one occasion and include:

- applying precautions and required action to minimise, control or eliminate identified hazards
- applying relevant legislation and workplace procedures
- communicating effectively with others when applying and monitoring security procedures
- completing relevant documentation
- identifying, selecting and using relevant equipment, processes and procedures for maintaining security
- implementing control measures
- interpreting and following operational instructions, procedures and information
- modifying activities depending on operational controls, risk situations and environments
- monitoring work activities in terms of planned schedule
- interpreting and following relevant instructions, procedures and information
- receiving, acknowledging and sending messages with available communications equipment
- working collaboratively with others when applying and monitoring security procedures
- working systematically with required attention to detail without injury to self or others, or damage to goods or equipment.

Knowledge Evidence

Evidence required to demonstrate competence in this unit must be relevant to and satisfy all of the requirements of the elements and performance criteria and include knowledge of:

- agency services including:
 - ambulance
 - fire
 - police
 - security
- marking and numbering systems
- national and international codes of practice and regulations relevant to security arrangements
- relevant bond, quarantine or other legislative requirements
- relevant work health safety (WHS)/occupational health and safety (OHS) and environmental

protection procedures and guidelines

- security problems and appropriate actions to resolve or avoid these problems
- site layout and operating procedures
- types of hazardous material and special handling procedures
- work systems, equipment, management and site operating systems
- workplace security procedures and policies.

Assessment Conditions

Assessors must hold credentials specified within the Standards for Registered Training Organisations current at the time of assessment.

Assessment must satisfy the Principles of Assessment and Rules of Evidence and all regulatory requirements included within the Standards for Registered Training Organisations current at the time of assessment.

Assessment must occur in workplace operational situations where it is appropriate to do so; where this is not appropriate, assessment must occur in simulated workplace operational situations that replicate workplace conditions.

Assessment processes and techniques must be appropriate to the language, literacy and numeracy requirements of the work being performed and the needs of the candidate.

Resources for assessment must include:

- relevant and appropriate materials, tools, equipment and personal protective equipment (PPE) currently used in industry
- applicable documentation including legislation, regulations, codes of practice, workplace procedures and operation manuals.
