Application

This unit involves the skills and knowledge required to conduct safety and hazard control procedures for transferring explosives/dangerous/hazardous/high risk goods, in accordance with relevant state/territory regulations.

It includes clarifying movements of explosives, hazardous or high risk goods; implementing safety and hazard control procedures for loading, unloading or goods movement activities; and reviewing and completing goods transfer operations.

Work is performed under general supervision.

| | 3.3 | Specialised equipment used for the process is maintained and stored in accordance with workplace procedures |
| | 3.4 | Worksite is checked and returned to operational status |
