# TLIX0052 Apply technical regulatory framework compliance management systems

## Modification History

**Release 1.** This is the first release of this unit of competency in the TLI Transport and Logistics Training Package.

## Application

This unit involves the skills and knowledge required to apply technical regulatory framework compliance management systems.

It includes preparing for compliance roles and responsibilities and applying technical compliance management systems. It also includes validating individual application of technical compliance management processes and procedures established by an organisation to fulfil its obligations and responsibilities under applicable compliance requirements.

This unit was developed for technical regulatory framework specialists working within materiel logistics but may be applicable to individuals in broader logistics roles.

Individuals work independently or as part of a team under direct or indirect supervision, use discretion and judgement, and take responsibility for the quality of their outputs. All activities are carried out in accordance with relevant organisational policy and procedures.

No licensing, legislative or certification requirements apply to this unit at the time of publication.

	<b>3.3</b>	Problems in applying technical compliance management system and in particular, breach of compliance requirements, are identified and appropriate action is initiated to address problems concerned
	<b>3.4</b>	Reports on identified breaches of compliance requirements and related action taken are prepared and processed to responsible authority or stakeholders
	<b>3.5</b>	Records of technical regulatory framework activities are maintained in accordance with approved systems requirements
