Application

This unit describes the skills and knowledge required to operate a carton strapping machine.

This unit applies to individuals who work under general supervision in a workplace where meat products or pet meat products are packed in cartons, and the cartons are strapped either manually or automatically.

All work must be carried out to comply with workplace procedures, according to state/territory health and safety and food safety regulations, legislation and standards that apply to the workplace.

Mandatory workplace requirements apply to the assessment of this unit.

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Assessment Requirements for AMPPKG206 Operate strapping machine

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Performance Evidence

An individual demonstrating competency must satisfy all of the elements and performance criteria in this unit.

There must be evidence that the individual has effectively operated the strapping machine, following manufacturer specifications and work instructions.

The assessor must observe the individual operating the equipment, including start-up procedures and maintenance, following workplace requirements, for a minimum of 10 minutes.

There must also be evidence that the individual has completed two shifts on the job fulfilling workplace requirements (these shifts may include normal rotations into and out of the relevant work task).

Mandatory workplace requirements

All performance evidence specified above must be demonstrated in a meat processing premises.

Knowledge Evidence

An individual must be able to demonstrate the knowledge required to perform the tasks outlined in the elements and performance criteria of this unit. This includes knowledge of:

- workplace requirements for operating strapping machine
- purpose of strapping cartons
- the need to maintain intact and undamaged cartons by strapping
- basic operating principles of equipment
- hazards associated with the operation of strapping machines, and how the associated risks are controlled
- faults that typically occur with the strapping process, such as covered labels, seals not holding.

Assessment Conditions

Assessment of the skills in this unit of competency must take place under the following conditions:

- physical conditions:
 - skills must be demonstrated in a meat processing premises at workplace production speed
- resources, equipment and materials:
 - personal protective equipment
 - cartons for strapping
 - strapping consumables
- specifications:
 - task-related documents
- personnel:
 - access to team members and/or supervisor.

Assessment for this unit must include at least three forms of evidence.

Assessors of this unit must satisfy the requirements for assessors in applicable vocational education and training legislation, frameworks and/or standards.
