Application

This unit describes the skills and knowledge required to remove the skin or hide of a condemned carcase.

This unit applies to those who work independently to skin animals condemned in the yards of slaughtering or game processing premises. The task may also be performed in a rendering plant.

All work must be carried out to comply with workplace procedures, according to state/territory health and safety and food safety regulations, legislation and standards that apply to the workplace.

Mandatory workplace requirements apply to the assessment of this unit.

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Performance Evidence

An individual demonstrating competency must satisfy all of the elements and performance criteria in this unit.

There must be evidence that the individual has removed the skin or hide of a condemned carcase, following workplace procedures.

The assessor must observe the individual skinning a minimum of one condemned carcase, or for a minimum of 15 minutes.

There must also be evidence that the individual has completed two shifts on the job, fulfilling workplace requirements (these shifts may include normal rotations into and out of the relevant work task).

Mandatory workplace requirements

All performance evidence specified above must be demonstrated in a meat processing premises.

Knowledge Evidence

An individual must be able to demonstrate the knowledge required to perform the tasks outlined in the elements and performance criteria of this unit. This includes knowledge of:

- workplace requirements for skinning condemned carcasses
- purpose of removing skin or hide from condemned carcase
- safe handling of hoists and equipment
- workplace health and safety hazards encountered when working with condemned carcasses, and how the associated risks are controlled
- contamination risks that can occur when working with condemned carcasses
- risks to hide quality through inaccurate skinning cuts.

Assessment Conditions

Assessment of the skills in this unit of competency must take place under the following conditions:

- physical conditions:
 - skills must be demonstrated in a meat processing premises at workplace production speed
- resources, equipment and materials:
 - personal protective equipment
 - knives
 - hoist
 - condemned carcasses
- specifications:
 - workplace standard operating procedures, work instructions and task-related documents.

Assessment for this unit must include at least three forms of evidence.

Assessors of this unit must satisfy the requirements for assessors in applicable vocational education and training legislation, frameworks and/or standards.
