Qualification Description

This qualification reflects the role of individuals who work in a management capacity in a small to medium sized equine establishment or who function as part of a management team in a larger equine establishment. Individuals in these roles have a high degree of autonomy and manage staff, horses and operations in a range of equine workplaces which may include performance horse or sport establishments, agistment centres, and coaching/riding centres or similar.

No licensing, legislative or certification requirements apply to this qualification at the time of publication.

Entry Requirements

Prior to commencing this qualification an individual must:

- have completed the following units of competency (or equivalent):
 - ACMEQU212 Handle horses safely
 - ACMEQU306 Provide routine care for horses
 - ACMEQU313 Work safely in equine workplaces
- OR

have relevant equivalent skills and knowledge acquired through participation in the equine industry.

Packaging Rules

To achieve this qualification, competency must be demonstrated in:

- 14 units of competency:
 - 8 core units plus
 - 6 elective units.

Elective units must ensure the integrity of the qualification's Australian Qualifications Framework (AQF) alignment and contribute to a valid, industry-supported vocational outcome. The electives are to be chosen as follows:

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- up to 6 from electives listed below
- up to 2 from any currently endorsed Training Package or accredited course.
