Modification History

Release 1. This is the first release of this qualification in the AVI Aviation Training Package.

Qualification Description

This qualification is for roles requiring general and specialist skills to operate effectively in a broad range of transport security screening roles.

Transport Security Screening Officer job roles may include:

- Air Cargo Examination Officer
- Airport Screening Officer
- Maritime Screening Officer.

This qualification includes the units of competency required by Transport Security Screening Officers to perform transport security screening functions including, controlling access to security sensitive areas, undertaking physical searches, and identifying and managing weapons, explosives and prohibited items. A Transport Security Screening Officer must also apply effective communication skills to work in a broad range of transport security protection roles.

Transport Security screening personnel working at this level will apply knowledge and skills to demonstrate autonomy and limited judgement in structured and stable contexts within narrow parameters.

Individuals seeking accreditation as a Transport Security Screening Officer should check industry specific accreditation requirements with Department of Home Affairs (DoHA) or its successor.

This qualification contains one not for public access (NFPA) restricted unit of competency. Content of NFPA units of competency is not published on the National Register. Access to this unit of competency is critical to security screening operations. Content of this unit is maintained separately and is only available to Registered Training Organisations (RTO's) authorised by DoHA. Entry Requirements

Individuals undertaking this qualification must have passed a valid background check prior to accessing security-restricted resources associated with AVIG0006 Work effectively in a transport security environment. A valid background check for the purposes of an individual undertaking the qualification is a background check on an applicant for, or the holder of an aviation security identification card or maritime security identification card.

Packaging Rules

Candidates must specialise in a specific stream by completing one of the following:

Certificate II in Transport Security Protection (Air Cargo Examination Officer)

A total of 9 units of competency comprising:

- 4 core units plus
- 1 unit from Group A plus
- 2 units from Group B plus
- 2 elective units from anywhere in this qualification or up to 2 units may be selected from any relevant nationally endorsed Training Package or accredited course.

Certificate II in Transport Security Protection (Airport Screening Officer)

A total of 11 units of competency comprising:

- 4 core units plus
- 1 unit from Group A plus
- 4 units from Group C plus
- 2 elective units from anywhere in this qualification or up to 2 units may be selected from any relevant nationally endorsed Training Package or accredited course.

Certificate II in Transport Security Protection (Maritime Screening Officer)

A total of 11 units of competency comprising:

- 4 core units plus
- 1 unit from Group A plus
- 3 units from Group D plus
- 3 elective units from anywhere in this qualification. Up to 2 of the elective units may be selected from any relevant nationally endorsed Training Package or accredited course.

Please note: RTO to insert on the testamur, the specialist elective unit group selected.

Where imported units are selected, they must contribute to the vocational outcomes of the qualification and care must be taken to ensure that all prerequisite units are complied with. Where a prerequisite is attached to a unit it is identified by the symbol ⊥
