This qualification reflects the role of individuals working in a variety of dance teaching contexts, including private dance studios. They apply solutions to a defined range of unpredictable problems and analyse and evaluate information relating to the assessment of dance students. They may provide leadership and guidance to others and have limited responsibility for the output of others.

The job roles that relate to this qualification may include dance fitness instructor or dance teacher.
