- responsibility of appropriate personnel for conducting and participating in evaluations
- criteria
- responsibilities for implementation of the evaluation plans
- means of protection of participants
- agreement for data collection, storage and retrieval
- procedures for editing and disseminating reports
- agreement of the financing

2.5 Identify, develop and assess validity and reliability of evidence gathering instruments, procedures and sources of information

3 Conduct the evaluation

3.1 Collect evidence in accordance with agreed evaluation plan

3.2 Identify and record potentially useful information which is not identified in the evaluation plan

3.3 Collate and process data relevant to the evaluation

4 Report on evaluation findings

4.1 Document issues and conclusions arising from the analysis conducted

4.2 Make recommendations to stakeholders on areas of possible improvement

- 4.3** Discuss preliminary findings with stakeholders
- 4.4** Prepare a range of reports to meet the differing needs of stakeholders
