Qualification Description

This qualification is designed for job roles in the timber merchandising sector of the forest and forest products industry.

Job roles

- Customer Service / Sales Assistant (Retail or Wholesale)
- Customer Service Officer
- Sales and Merchandising Team Leader
- Sales and Merchandising Team Leader (Timber Products)
- Timber Advisor

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Packaging Rules

To be awarded the FWP30616 Certificate III in Timber Merchandising, competency must be achieved in **thirteen** (13) units of competency.

five (5) core units of competency

eight (8) units of competency from the elective group, consisting of:

3 units from Group A

5 units from Group A and/or Group B, the total of which can include up to two units recommended for packaging at Certificate II, III or IV level from this or any other endorsed Training Package or state/territory accredited course.

Elective units must be relevant to work undertaken in the timber merchandising sector of the industry.
