Qualification Description

This qualification reflects the role of first aid or medical response workers who provide basic health care services including emergency first aid and sometimes transport services in the pre-hospital and out-of-hospital environment. The qualification applies to people who provide a first response in workplaces such as industrial sites, first aid organisations and the Australian Defence Force (ADF).

No occupational licensing, certification or specific legislative requirements apply to this qualification at the time of publication.

Packaging Rules

11 units must be completed:

- 7 core units
- 4 elective units, consisting of:
 - at least 2 units from the electives listed below
 - up to 1 unit from the electives listed below or from any other current endorsed Training Package or accredited course.

The selection of electives must be relevant to the job outcome sought, local industry requirements and the complexity of skills appropriate to the AQF level of this qualification.
