This qualification reflects the role of an individual such as a roustabout, lease hand, utility operator, floorman or motorman working in drilling oil and gas (onshore) or well servicing operations. They are required to undertake a prescribed range of functions involving known routines and procedures.

All elective units selected from outside this qualification must reflect current occupational and learning outcomes of this AQF qualification level.

To be appointed under any statutory requirements in related roles, units of competency should be selected to meet the state/territory licensing requirements.
