Qualification Description

This qualification reflects the role of mine managers who perform tasks that are broad, specialised, complex and technical and include strategic areas and initiating activities. They are required to demonstrate self-directed application of theoretical and technical knowledge and initiate solutions to technical problems or management requirements.

No licensing, legislative or certification requirements apply to this qualification at the time of publication.

Entry Requirements

There are no entry requirements for this qualification.

Packaging Rules

- at least one (1) must be chosen from Group A

All elective units selected from outside this qualification must reflect current occupational and learning outcomes of this AQF qualification level.
