Obtain and interpret emergency procedures and be prepared for fire/accident/emergency
2. Operate spreader	2.1. Coordinate activities with others prior to commencing, during and on completion of the work activity 2.2. Carry out pre-start, start-up, park-up and shutdown procedures 2.3. Operate spreader controls to place burden

3. Relocate spreader	<p>3.1. Receive and confirm route and location plan, if necessary by site inspection</p> <p>3.2. Complete ground preparation</p> <p>3.3. Carry out cable location and handling</p> <p>3.4. Coordinate relocation issues, including support equipment and personnel</p>
4. Carry out operator maintenance	<p>4.1. Prepare machine for maintenance</p> <p>4.2. Conduct inspection and fault finding techniques and processes</p> <p>4.3. Carry out scheduled maintenance tasks</p> <p>4.4. Process written maintenance records</p>
