Release 1. This is the first release of this qualification in the TLI Transport and Logistics Training Package.

Qualification Description

This is a general qualification for those engaged in supply chain operations.

It involves a broad range of skilled applications including planning and preparing for work in a supply chain environment, working effectively with others, demonstrating care and working safely.

This is an entry-level qualification for the supply chain environment. It involves the breadth, depth and complexity of knowledge and skills required to prepare a person to perform a defined range of activities, most of which may be routine and predictable.

Job roles

Job roles and titles vary across different sectors. Possible job titles relevant to this qualification include:

- logistics assistant
- logistics general hand
- warehouse general hand
- storeperson.

No licensing, legislative or certification requirements apply to this qualification at the time of publication.

Entry Requirements

There are no entry requirements for this qualification.

Packaging Rules

A total of **8 units of competency** comprising:

- 4 core units listed below, plus
- 4 elective units from the elective units listed below.

Up to **2 of the elective units** may be selected from any relevant nationally endorsed Training Package or accredited course. The elective units must contribute to the vocational outcomes of the qualification.
